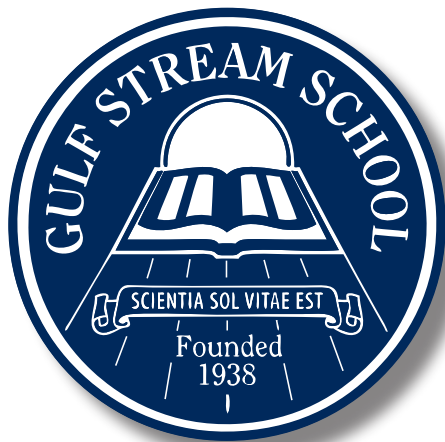


MISSION STATEMENT
